

MINUTES OF THE TEACHERS' MEETINGS

Romania:

1. Send initial and final questionnaire to everyone
2. Prepare presentations about your country, region, school system, school (for the first day of the meeting)
3. Programme must be available asap because some have to submit the programme (Doesn't have to be the final version)
4. Tell everyone what to prepare for the Labyrinth Theatre

Greece:

1. Final Play will be divided into seven parts, every country will get the script and its part this week (Email from Agiris)
2. Main roles will be played by Greek students

Everyone:

1. Prepare 10 minutes presentation for Romania about a play (We are all European citizens with our similarities and differences)
 - The presentations should be as interesting as possible (e.g. interview, posters...)
2. Write dialogues for the final play and send it to Agiris until 1st of July
 - 5-6 pages
 - In Poland we will discuss who will play which role
 - Maybe we can have online auditions (skype etc.) => has to be discussed in Romania again
3. Organisation of student's work during the meetings and the final performance at the end of the week:
 - One or two teachers (English-speaking) have to be with the students and help them to rewrite the dialogues and practice the sketches
 - Students need clear instructions what to do
 - 30-60 minutes for rehearsal before the performance
 - Prepare an introduction before we start with the performance
 - Prepare some questions for the discussion after the performances
 - o Why did you choose this sketch?
 - o In how far is the topic represented?
 - o What is your personal opinion?
 - o Was it easy or difficult to practice because of cultural differences or language problems?
 - o Etc.
 - Introduction and discussion should be done by a teacher
4. Send details for meeting in Poland to Polish teachers until June
 - o How many students and teachers?
 - o What kind of rooms for the teachers (single, double...)?

5. Remember to upload documents like the programme on e-twinning! Not everyone uses facebook and e-twinning is safer...
