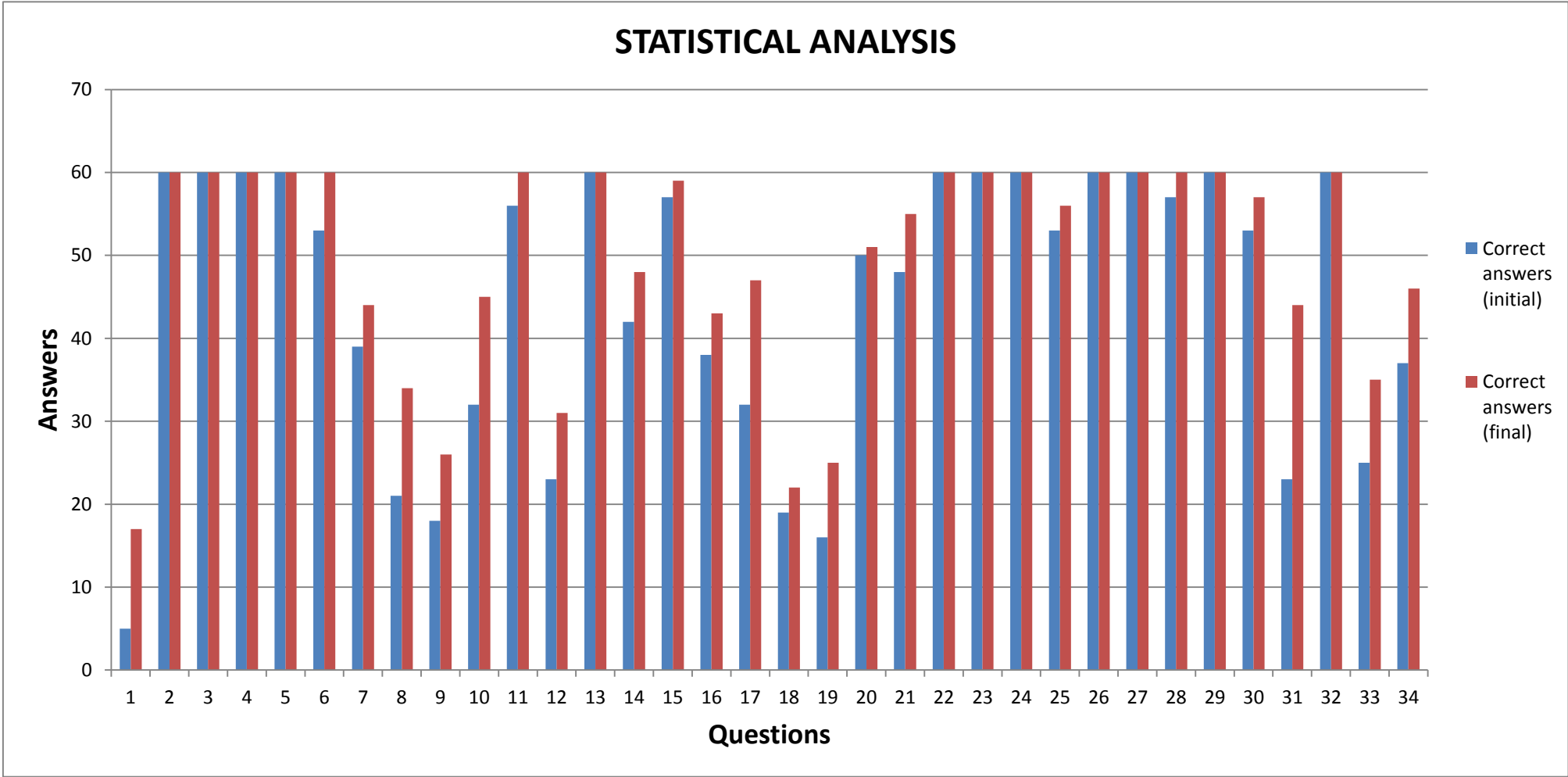

The partner schools created a questionnaire including thirty questions related to the history, geography and culture of the participating countries. The survey was conducted among 60 Bulgarian students. The statistical analysis of the questionnaire which was carried out at the beginning of the project showed that the students had a broad knowledge of Greece, Romania and Italy, a good knowledge of Germany, they didn't know Poland and Finland very well. There is the same tendency in the results of the questionnaire at the end of the project, but the number of the correct answers is higher. The comparative analysis shows that the students have increased their knowledge of the participating countries.
